Kevin was one of three Oklahoma Subject Matter Experts (SME) for Lexipol and has served as an Assessor with the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Accreditation Program (OLEAP) since 2006. He remains active in law enforcement serving as a Reserve Special Agent and Chief Chaplain for the Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs. Kevin was recently inducted into the Hall of Fame for City and Town Officials.

Kevin began his career in 1980 with the Mustang Police Department as a part-time Animal Control Officer, later serving as a Sergeant with the Oklahoma City Police Department, Criminal Investigator with the Oklahoma Office of the Attorney General, and Chief of Police for the Earlsboro Police Department.
