From 2009 to 2014, Ms. Burke continued her service with the Maricopa County Sheriff's Office in Arizona. There, she served on the TechoCops warrant team, the Dignitary Protection Team, Extradition Detail, and took on roles as a DUI Task Force Coordinator and General Instructor, further honing her skills in law enforcement operations and training.

In 2017, a personal experience ignited her passion for genetic genealogy, leading her to immerse herself in the study of DNA analysis and its applications in law enforcement. Recognizing the profound potential of this technology to swiftly and accurately identify suspects and unidentified deceased persons, she launched the **Genetic Genealogy for Law Enforcement** program in 2021. Through this initiative, Christine provides specialized training to federal, state, county, and local agencies, equipping them with cutting-edge tools and techniques in forensic genetic genealogy. She also offers services such as genetic matching and assistance in search warrant preparation.

To honor fallen officers, Ms. Burke established the **Enduring Service** award program in 2022. This initiative offers complimentary genetic genealogy training to agencies that have lost an officer in the line of duty, reflecting her commitment to supporting the law enforcement community.

Christine is a licensed private investigator and agency owner, a court-qualified law enforcement expert witness, and a Forensic Genetic Genealogist. She holds a bachelor's degree in criminal justice from Florida Atlantic University and a master's degree in organizational management from the University of Phoenix.
