



Sergeant William “Conrad” Mauer

Conrad Mauer is a Sergeant with the Cedar Park Police Department. He has 23 years’ experience in law enforcement, with 18 years sworn and 5 years as a support staff member.

Sgt. Mauer began his unexpected career path to law enforcement as an employee of a civilian gun club, in rural Southeast Texas. He rose through the ranks, eventually becoming the General Manager of the 200+ acre facility.

There he became involved at every level of facilitating competitive, charity, and recreational Skeet, Trap, and Sporting Clay events. He frequently taught youth and adult recreational and competitive shotguns sports, and there found his passion for firearms and teaching.

In 2003, Sgt. Mauer was hired by the Texas Department of Public Safety. He worked as a civilian support staff member at the newly built Texas Department of Public Safety Tactical Firearms Training Facility, in the Central Texas area. There he assisted sworn members with the daily operation and needs of the 1000+ acre facility. He also facilitated the needs of outside agencies utilizing the facility.

In 2006, Sgt. Mauer graduated from Capital Area Council of Government Regional Law Enforcement Academy, and was hired by the Cedar Park Police Department. His assignments included: Patrol Officer, Field Training Officer, Patrol Corporal, Professional Standards Investigator, Patrol Sergeant, Narcotics Unit Supervisor, and his current position as the Training Unit Supervisor.

Sgt. Mauer became a TCOLE Instructor in 2010, and holds approximately 30 instructor certifications, with a primary focus on the use of force, weapons, and tactics. He frequently teaches in the Central Texas Area to Peace Officers, Fire Fighters, Police Cadets, businesses, and members of the public.
