Officer Guasto began his career with the Miami Beach Police Department in 2006, where he has held a variety of roles including Patrol Officer, CST Detective and Drug K9 Handler, Traffic Homicide Unit Detective, and Technical Operations Unit Detective. His investigative work has spanned traffic fatalities, impaired driving enforcement, and long-term proactive gang investigations, earning him recognition for excellence in DUI enforcement, roadway safety initiatives, and criminal intelligence operations.

In his current assignment with the department's Training Unit, Officer Guasto serves as Program Manager for the Police Jiu-Jitsu Program, leading the development of a modern combatives curriculum. He is a certified Axon TASER Master Instructor and Axon VR Trainer, delivering immersive training experiences that enhance officer readiness and decision-making under stress.

A recognized force analyst, Officer Guasto conducts in-depth response-to-resistance evaluations and use-of-force reviews, supporting policy refinement and tactical readiness. He contributes to crisis communication strategies as a trainer for the Hostage Negotiation Team and facilitates community training sessions on active shooter response and public safety education.

As a Drug Recognition Expert (DRE) Instructor, Officer Guasto has played a pivotal role in impaired driving enforcement and education. He has trained officers in identifying drug-impaired drivers and contributed to the development of traffic mitigation plans for major city events and emergencies. His expertise in traffic safety is further demonstrated through his authorship of FDOT grant proposals, the creation of performance metrics to evaluate enforcement program impact, and his selection to participate in state-level impaired

driving program assessments conducted by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA)—contributing to national evaluations and best practices.
